Basketball Shooting Terms and Slang

1. Air ball:

Meaning: Completely miss the basket

Example sentences:

- Oh my! Air ball.
- That was an sir ball.
- Can't believe I shot an airball.

2. Brick:

Meaning: Bad shot that hits the rim or backboard.

Example sentences:

- What a brick!
- Too many bricks.
- Complete brick.

Meaning: Very clean shot, nothing but net.

- You keep swoosh'n it.
- Swoosh is a beautiful sound.

Example sentences:

- That was a great bank.
- Good bank shot.
- Way to use the bank shot.
